



Plans for 2009 - 2010 School Year Home Edition

All activities for the year follow a central theme,
with a different topic of focus each week.

Proposed school week:

Tuesdays

Field trips and "Park" days

Not included in plans – pay only for the days you attend.

- Field trips are held at various theme-related Southern California venues.
- "Park" days are 45-minute topic introductions and activities held at the Disneyland parks.

These activities will generally alternate each week.

Parents are encouraged to stay, but drop-off arrangements can be made.

Wednesdays

Topic presentations

Two hours of fun, fast-paced activities

Parents encouraged to stay, but drop-off arrangements can be made.

Parent meetings are held at the end of these activities.

Thursdays

Collaborations/classes

Two 1-hour learning sessions

These are longer collaboration projects and/or more focused six-week classes.

Parents are welcome, but not required to stay.

Eleventh student is free.

One 2-hour session a week

(Topic presentations only)

5 students for four weeks

Additional students: \$40 each

Eleventh student is free.

Fee Details

- Notice that the lump sum covers five students for four weeks.
- If you don't see a plan that suits you, please discuss your needs with us so we can customize a plan for you.
- Fees are due one week prior to the start of the activities.
- The activities are geared to approximate ages 6-13, although both older and younger students are welcome to participate. The fees apply to any students that participate.
- Non-participating siblings should have another space to play where they will not be a distraction to the paying students.

Additional Services

“Park” Days: \$24 per student for four “park” days or \$7 per student for one “park” day

Educational activities at the park – the theme park, that is! Each week is 45-minutes of learning activities, including a Disney Theme Park attraction. You may choose the weeks that you attend – they do not have to be sequential. Admission to the parks is not included. All annual passes are valid on these days.

Field Trips: Varies by venue

Six-week classes: Varies. Often \$60

Take-home Materials \$50 increments

Allowance: The dollar amount that you pay is the dollar amount of materials (mostly books) that you may choose to take home with you. These materials have no due dates, but you are permitted to exchange the materials any time you like. Your allowance is also the dollar amount of materials that you keep at the end of the year.

Enrollment: \$100 per family

Enrollment is not required and is only available to families who have at least one student who attends Celebration’s activities. “Enrollment” means that Celebration Education keeps your official school records. Each student can only be enrolled with one school at a time, so if you file your own private school affidavit, belong to a charter school, or are enrolled with another private school satellite program, you do not need to pay this fee.

Responsibilities of the host family:

- Host topic presentations, classes, and collaborations.
 - May be held in your home or another venue of your choosing.
 - The cost of the use of a facility is not included in the plans.
- Recruit other families to participate.
 - You invite the families that you feel comfortable hosting.
 - If you like, Celebration Education may help find families.
- Collect monies from families and pay Celebration Education.
 - Payment must be made in advance.
 - You may decide how much to charge individuals, adding in cost of venue, if necessary.
