The activities are geared to approximate ages 6-12, although both older and younger students enjoy the activities and are welcome to participate. The fees in option 1 apply to any students that participate, regardless of age.

Explanations

Set-up cost: This charge may be waived. In which case, all the lesson plans and materials for four weeks will be provided to you all in one kit and you will be responsible for organizing the lessons and materials each week. This option would work best for the groups who are already familiar with the Celebration Education format. If this option appeals to you, please let us know.

Teacher training: Teacher training will be held on a monthly basis at a central location. Both Celebration Education employees and host-teachers are invited to come for free training and encouragement and to pick up materials. These training sessions are not required for host-teachers.

Materials delivery: If a host-teacher is unable to attend the training sessions, the lesson plans and materials can be delivered to your location at the cost described above.

Lesson development and preparation: Rich lessons like these can take two whole days to plan, but who wants to do that? Let us do it all for you! Activities come ready to go, materials and all.

Lesson materials are the unique materials that are needed for each particular lesson; supplies are the everyday school supplies that may be used from week to week. This includes pencils, markers, crayons, scissors, stick glue, blank paper, etc.

Online lesson outlines and inquiries: Each family in your group will have access to a private social network for this theme. The inquiries listed there are ideas you can use as follow-up to the topics that are discussed in the weekly lessons. If you are in a charter school, your educational specialist may also have free access to this information.

Library program: This is optional. Save a trip to the public library! The dollar amount that you pay is the dollar amount of materials (mostly books) that you may choose to take home with you. These materials have no due dates, but you are permitted to exchange the materials any time you like. Your allowance is also the dollar amount of materials that you keep at the end of the year. As a host-teacher, you may choose to do the \$50 program just for your family.
